

Eligibility for Financial Support

Enbridge's community investments are guided by a core set of criteria. We consider support for and participation in community programs that are:

- based in the communities where we operate within a 20-kilometre radius of our pipeline right-of-way
- of prime importance to the community
- of benefit to the greatest number of people
- of long-term significance to the community

Examples of Qualified Organizations

- medical research and infrastructure
- community-based emergency services
- health-based organizations
- education providers
- social services agencies
- environmental and safety initiatives
- professional and amateur cultural organizations

Ineligible Organizations

- organizations without a Revenue Canada Taxation number
- organizations discriminating on the basis of race, religion, gender or sexual orientation.
- individuals
- religious, political organizations or special interest groups.
- advocacy or lobby initiatives. Corporate donations or sponsorships will not be permitted where the recipient organization allows the presence of special interest groups where it is deemed that their presence or participation is not in the spirit of the event or in the business interests of Enbridge (Canada)
- recreation or sports organizations
- trips, tours or conferences
- foundations or third party fundraisers

To Apply

Decisions normally will be made within six weeks of receipt of a complete application, however, decisions on major funding requests may take longer.

Organizations receiving funding may be asked to provide a final report detailing the results and benefits achieved through the funded project, program or campaign.
