**Re: Application to the National Energy Board (the "Board")
by Enbridge Pipelines Inc. ("Enbridge") dated December 19, 2005
for Orders pursuant to Part IV of the National Energy Board Act
approving a Negotiated Toll Settlement**

Enbridge encloses for filing one (1) copy of an application for approval of a toll settlement that has been negotiated between Enbridge and the Canadian Association of Petroleum Producers ("CAPP").

The settlement is a result of several months of negotiation between CAPP and Enbridge and represents an overall settlement of toll issues that is acceptable to both parties. The agreed upon methodology is expected to form the basis for the calculation of Enbridge's revenue requirement and the resulting tolls for the years 2005 - 2009 inclusive. Attached to Enbridge's application is a letter of support from CAPP in respect of the settlement.

This filing is organized into three sections:

- the Application section describes the nature of the settlement and the approvals Enbridge is seeking from the Board and includes CAPP's letter of support;
- the Principles of Settlement section describes in detail the basis of the settlement including the agreed upon methodology for calculating Enbridge's revenue requirement and the resulting tolls; and
- the Schedules and Appendices to Principles of Settlement section provides detailed information concerning the toll methodology calculations, metrics, performance and service level information, and copies of other settlements that remain in effect


during the duration of the present settlement and affect the calculation of tolls on the Enbridge system.

As was the case for the toll settlement approved pursuant to NEB Order TO-3-2000, the enclosed settlement continues to be based upon incentive toll principles whereby the pipeline and tollpayers share the benefits associated with cost savings achieved by the pipeline.

Enbridge respectfully requests a decision on the application by January 27, 2006. A decision by this date will facilitate Enbridge's reporting in its various 2005 year-end documents and enable timely capital and operating expenditures necessary to achieve many of the new incentive opportunities.
