

Safety is one of Enbridge's core values, it's at the very foundation of our business. That's why our pipelines are monitored around the clock using both people and computerized analysis. Our systems analyze pressure, temperature, and other important information from thousands of points all the way along our pipelines. All of our pipelines can be shut off remotely in a matter of minutes if a potential problem is detected.

Pipelines are safe, and built to last

The Federal agency that regulates pipelines—the Pipeline Hazardous Materials Safety Administration—states that pipelines are the safest, most environmentally-friendly, most efficient and reliable way of transporting crude oil. Our pipelines are built using the highest quality materials and are inspected inch-by-inch on a regular schedule using specialized MRI-like technology, similar to the medical industry, which can detect even small changes in our pipelines over time.

Our pipeline operations are highly regulated

As a company, we are responsible not only to the communities where we operate, but also to state and federal agencies and regulators. In fact, Enbridge announces projects publicly and follows a robust state and federal regulatory process.

As a company, Enbridge has invested nearly \$5 billion in alternative energy projects including wind, solar, geothermal and hydropower assets, and we will soon generate enough green energy to power more than one million homes. We are committed to doubling our renewable power generation capacity by 2019.
