Enbridge delivers the energy that fuels quality of life.

At Enbridge, our goal is to be the first-choice energy delivery company in North America and beyond – for customers, communities, investors, regulators and policymakers, and employees.

We operate in five of the G7 countries – the United States, Canada, the United Kingdom, France and Germany. We take a pragmatic, “all-of-the-above” approach to energy evolution. We transport energy safely and reliably, helping to keep it accessible and affordable. That commitment guides how we operate our diversified energy super systems, which together form one of North America’s most resilient delivery networks.

We’re advancing new technologies, including renewable natural gas, carbon capture and storage, and hydrogen, and are committed to achieving net-zero greenhouse gas emissions from our operations by 2050¹

We safely connect millions of people around the world to the energy they rely on every day through our four core businesses – natural gas pipelines, liquids pipelines, gas utilities and storage, and renewable energy.

Through our cross-continent natural gas transmission pipeline system, we deliver about 20% of the natural gas consumed in the U.S. – and serve the rapidly expanding North American LNG export market. We have capacity to serve 25% of LNG export capacity in the Gulf Coast, and in Canada, we’re integral to all West Coast LNG export projects aiming to serve growing global markets.

We move about 30% of the crude oil produced in North America, and load about 25% of the continent’s crude exports via our Enbridge Ingleside Energy Center (IEIC).

Enbridge operates North America’s largest natural gas utility by volume and customer count, delivering up to 9.3 Bcf/d of gas to about 7.1 million customers in Ohio, Ontario, Utah, North Carolina, Wyoming, Idaho and Quebec. Enbridge Gas was the first utility in North America to blend renewable hydrogen gas into its distribution system, and continues to pioneer lower-carbon energy sources.

Enbridge was an early investor in renewable energy, and we have a growing offshore wind portfolio in Europe. Collectively, our interests in renewable energy projects in operation or under construction have capacity to generate about 8 GW of zero-emission energy.

We value safety, integrity, respect, inclusion and high performance. Above all else, we aim to make a difference, economically and socially – as an industry leader, as a responsible corporate citizen, as an exceptional employer.

Enbridge was selected to S&P Global’s Sustainability Yearbook 2025, also receiving the Industry Mover distinction; we’ve been named to the Dow Jones Sustainability Indices’ (DJSI) North American index 15 times, most recently in 2024; we’ve earned an A-minus climate change grade from the Carbon Disclosure Project (CDP) for five straight years, most recently in 2024; and we have been ranked among Canada’s Top 100 Employers 22 times, most recently in 2025.

Enbridge Inc. is headquartered in Calgary, Canada. We have a workforce of more than 16,000 people, primarily in the United States and Canada. Enbridge (ENB) is traded on the New York and Toronto stock exchanges.
