Texas Eastern Transmission LP (Texas Eastern) is an indirect, wholly owned subsidiary of Enbridge Inc. The Texas Eastern interstate natural gas pipeline system operates in Pennsylvania and helps deliver natural gas for ultimate use by homes, businesses, manufacturers and power plants.

Enriken compressor unit replacement

The Enriken Compressor Station in Huntingdon County already supports the transportation of natural gas supplies within Pennsylvania and the broader region. As a part of the Appalachia to Market II and Armagh and Enriken HP Replacement Projects, we are proposing upgrades to the Enriken facility to optimize and strengthen our existing infrastructure network by replacing a natural gas-driven compressor unit with a new, energy-efficient electric-motor-driven unit. This upgrade will help improve reliability and provide additional natural gas transportation to serve utilities and meet the growing demand for clean, affordable, domestic energy.

By replacing the current unit at Enriken with an electric-motor-driven unit, we are reducing net air emissions while simultaneously increasing capacity and providing greater energy reliability.

Electric transmission needs

To accommodate the switch from a gas-driven compressor unit to an electric-motor-driven compressor unit at Enriken, an additional power line will be needed given the significant energy requirements of the new unit. The proposed power line expansion will directly enable the change to an electric-motor-driven compressor unit, resulting in improved environmental performance and a net reduction in air emissions, while continuing to provide reliable and affordable energy.
