

In 2005 Enbridge acquired the Flanagan Terminal, located in central Illinois near Pontiac, IL. It covers more than 400 acres in Livingston County.

This terminal has grown to become a major hub for Enbridge liquids operations in the U.S., as part of a crude oil pipeline delivery system transporting liquid petroleum from Canada. North Dakota and Montana to U.S. refineries to meet North America's energy needs. The workforce at the Flanagan Terminal has grown more than 600 percent over 12 years, with nearly 40 full-time Enbridge employees. Jobs within the terminal include: Engineer: Technician (Mechanical, Electrical, Operations, Lab, and Right-of-Way); Terminal Coordinator; Administrative Assistant; and Community Engagement Advisor.

Safe and reliable operations are the foundation of Enbridge's business at the Flanagan Terminal. Over the past decade, through 2019, Enbridge liquids pipelines have delivered more than **27.2** billion barrels of crude oil and other petroleum or natural gas liquids, with a safety record of 99.99976%.

Annually, we engage local Emergency Responders and provide support with training, equipment and donations.

All Enbridge pipelines are monitored 24/7, in addition to routine aerial right-of-way patrols. As the operators of vital energy infrastructure across North America, we understand that the public has entrusted us with the responsibility to deliver the energy we all need, safely and reliably.
