



Manhattan Terminal

In 2010 Enbridge constructed a new storage terminal for light hydrocarbons to support the transportation of diluent from near Chicago north to Western Canada.

The terminal is located outside Manhattan, IL, west of Chicago. It covers more than 30.8 acres with an additional 31.7 acres of adjacent property outside of the terminal site in Will County. This terminal has grown to become a vital component of Enbridge liquids operations in the U.S., as part of a crude oil pipeline delivery system transporting liquid petroleum from Canada to U.S. refineries to meet North America's energy needs.

The workforce at the Manhattan Terminal includes seven Enbridge employees. Jobs within the terminal include: Electrical and

Mechanical Technicians, Terminal Gaugers, Terminal Maintainers, and Area Supervisor.

Safe and reliable operations are the foundation of Enbridge's business at the Manhattan Terminal.
