Additional Observations and Summary of Activities or Concerns

With things winding down on construction activity, Banister crews continued with machine

clean-up, decompaction and breaking down clay piles and levelling of the right of way. Wet

land crossing ramp removal was on going this continued throughout the week, crews

removing geo tech membrane and cleaning the area of any debris. Track hoe operators

created breaks and excavated basins on the topsoil piles as well as on the roach line this is

done for sediment control for spring mitigation. On Thursday crews also completed the silt

fence installation at water course crossing Vipond Creek SK WC72 SSKP662.52 and wet

land crossing SK584 SSKP662.39-SSKP662.6 crews used a skid steer with a ditch-witch

attachment to excavate a 6-inch trench line and the workers installed the silt fence on the

west slope of the area.

The end of the week, spread 5 machine clean was completed, and the only outstanding item

remaining is the MLBV16 valve site, 2 piles were welded in the pit and once that process

was done the welds were tested and approved. Backfill of this MLBV16 valve site will be

carried out the following week.
