

Regulatory Process and Community Outreach

Line 3 Replacement is the most studied pipeline project in Minnesota's history.

2014

- First regulatory paperwork to PUC in October
- **235** community outreach meetings
- Seven Enbridge public open houses



2016

- EIS process begins
- **500** community outreach meetings
- Seven Enbridge landowner open houses on L3 deactivation
- Apr 11 – May 26 public comment period: Line 3 Scoping EAW and Draft EIS Scoping

2015

- CN and RP applications filed
- **365** community outreach meetings
- July 20 – Sept 30 public comment period: Line 3 Public Information and Environmental Analysis Scoping

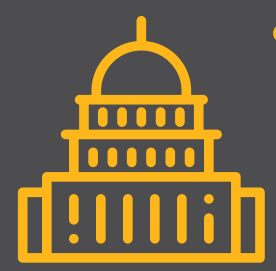
