



Venice Extension Project

Texas Eastern Transmission, LP (“Texas Eastern”), is a leading provider of natural gas transportation and storage services to many of the largest natural gas markets in the United States. The Venice Extension Project efficiently expands Texas Eastern’s existing infrastructure and transportation capacity to serve Venture Global’s proposed Plaquemines LNG export facility. Project facilities will be located in Pointe Coupee, Iberville, Lafourche and Plaquemines Parishes, Louisiana.

Once in-service, the Venice Extension Project will deliver up to 1.26 billion cubic feet per day of firm natural gas transportation supply to the Plaquemines LNG export facility located in Plaquemines Parish. The project is anticipated to be placed in-service in 2024.

Project overview

The Venice Extension Project is designed to minimize disturbances to landowners, communities, and the environment. Facilities and work will include:

- Construction of a 3-mile, 36-inch-diameter pipeline segment on Texas Eastern’s Line 40 in Pointe Coupee Parish
- Abandonment of a 2.2-mile pipeline segment
- Upgrade a metering and regulating facility in Plaquemines Parish
- Construction of a 31,900-horsepower compressor station and related facilities in Pointe Coupee Parish
- Installation and modification of various equipment and facilities, including abandoning in-place and installing new compressor units, at existing sites in Iberville and Lafourche Parishes

Project benefits

The Venice Extension Project connects North American supply to growing gulf coast markets and improves and diversifies the energy supply.
