The rates listed in this tariff for transportation within the United States are subject to the Rules and Regulations published in North Dakota Pipeline Company LLC FERC No. 2.12.0 and Bakken Pipeline Company LP FERC No.1.4.0, and successive issues thereof, while the crude petroleum is in the custody of each carrier, respectively.

The joint rates in this tariff for pipeline transportation are expressed in U.S. cents per barrel.

The provisions published herein will, if effective, not result in an effect on the quality of the human environment.

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The rates listed in this tariff are payable in United States currency and are applicable on the movement of Crude Petroleum tendered to North Dakota Pipeline Company LLC at established receiving points in the United States for the purpose of transportation to the Bakken Pipeline Company LP delivery point of international boundary near Portal (Burke County), North Dakota, in the United States.
